SINGING: A Biblical Basis

Scripture:

Shout with joy to the Lord, all the earth! Worship the Lord with gladness. Come before him, singing with joy.

Psalm 100:1-2 (NLT)

Then I will hold my head high above my enemies who surround me. At his sanctuary I will offer sacrifices with shouts of joy, singing and praising the Lord with music.

Psalm 27:6 (NLT)

Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts.

Ephesians 5:18-19 (NLT)

Those who plant in tears will harvest with shouts of joy. They weep as they go to plant their seed, but they sing as they return with the harvest.

Psalm 126:5-6 (NLT)

Then I will praise God's name with singing, and I will honor him with thanksgiving.

Psalm 69:30 (NLT)

The Lord lives! Praise to my Rock! May God, the Rock of my salvation, be exalted! He is the God who pays back those who harm me; he brings down the nations under me and delivers me from my enemies. Four Ways to Get Started and Keep Going!

Following are four suggestions to help you personally apply this aspect of the 12 in daily prayer.

A Practical Prayer Summary
Step 9 in World-Changing Prayer

1. Pause in your devotional hour to sing a specific song unto the Lord.
2. Select a special theme for your song, such as praise, thanksgiving or a favorite passage of Scripture.
3. Ask the Holy Spirit to create an original melody in your heart so your song is truly “a new song.”
4. Don't hesitate to sing songs of thanksgiving for specific blessings or victories you believe God will give you in the days ahead.
