Revelations (A Journey to the Word)

Scripture:

By your words I can see where I'm going; they throw a beam of light on my dark path.

Psalm 119:105 (MSG)

Definitions:

"Symbol"

"Something that stands for, represents or suggests another thing" (e.g., a dove is a symbol of peace). "Something that conveys a much greater reality."

"Source"

"A spring or fountain that is the starting point of a stream; that from which something comes into existence, develops or derives."
